SUMMARY OF PROJECT

S2R are partnering with Ravensthorpe CCL, Lead Anchor meeting with Partner Anchor 20th October 2021 we decided that a launch of the Anchor partnership combined with a community consultation event would be a useful way of getting the Anchor project recognised, other services involved and the local community, the event to be held at Ravensthorpe CCL, we decided on theme - Community Safety.

People were asked to fill in a simple survey about what community safety concerns them and free safety items to take away were available e.g. reflective bands. People also had the opportunity to discuss issues with local police and Cllrs.
