FOR THE LOCAL ELECTIONS ON 4 MAY 2023...

YOU NEED ID TO VOTE AT POLLING STATIONS

You need to bring ID to vote at polling stations for the local elections on 4 May 2023 – this can be either photo ID or a Voter Certificate.

Voters who are registered to vote in Kirklees will be asked to show ID before their ballot paper is issued. Postal voting doesn't change.

The full list of what types of photo ID that will be accepted can be found below:

- **Passport** issued by the UK, any of the Channel Islands, the Isle of Man, a British Overseas Territory, an EEA state, or a Commonwealth country
- **Driving licence** issued by the UK, any of the Channel Islands, the Isle of Man, or an EEA state
- **Biometric immigration document**
- **PASS card** – an identity card bearing the Proof of Age Standards Scheme hologram
- **Ministry of Defence Form 90** (Defence Identity Card)
- **Blue Badge** parking permit
- **National identity card** issued by an EEA state
- **Older Person's Bus Pass**
- **Disabled Person's Bus Pass**
- **Oyster 60+ Card**
- **Freedom Pass**
- **Scottish National Entitlement Card** issued in Scotland
- **60 and Over Welsh Concessionary Travel Card** issued in Wales
- **Disabled Person's Welsh Concessionary Travel Card** issued in Wales
- **Senior SmartPass** issued in Northern Ireland
- **Registered Blind SmartPass or Blind Person's SmartPass** issued in Northern Ireland
- **60+ SmartPass** issued in Northern Ireland
- **Half Fare SmartPass** issued in Northern Ireland
- **Electoral Identity Card** issued in Northern Ireland

All ID documents must be the original

NO ID? NO PROBLEM.

Don't have anything on the list? Don't worry.

Anyone without the correct identification can apply for a **Voter Authority Certificate (VAC)** free of charge from the Government website.

Once issued your Voter Authority Certificate can be used as your photo ID at the local election on 4 May 2023. It will last for around 10 years and can be used for all elections in that time. VACs are a form of photo ID for use at the polling station only.
